SAN BERNARDINO– Due to the recent surge in COVID-19 (Coronavirus) cases and related health and safety concerns, Governor Gavin Newsom will begin issuing revised Stay-at-Home orders as soon as today. **As an essential function, all court locations will remain open with strict safety protocols in place.** Do not come to any court location if you have COVID-19, have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, are feeling ill, or have been asked to quarantine by a health professional.

Additionally, new jury trials will be paused; see below for more information:

- **Effective Monday, December 7**, there will be no new jury trials started until the new Stay-at-Home orders expire
